How Often Should I Replace my Disposable Fluid Paths?

One of the key features that sets our filling equipment apart from other systems is our disposable fluid path valve technology. Over time, the disposable fluid path will begin to degrade and the luer-lock adapter may start to lose its threading. But, how often should you change the disposable fluid path and connectors?

Every application is unique so it's hard to say how often you should replace the tube. Multiple factors such as the material being filled, the frequency of use, and amount of handling will all influence how often the tube should be replaced.
